Dr. Alexandra Drossou-Berendes (GEOMAR)

Does GEOMAR offer support when I look for funding?

The acquisition of funding for the implementation of research ideas is an integral part of the daily work of a scientist. The Research Funding team at GEOMAR provides support in all aspects of research funding: to identify the appropriate support instruments or partners for project ideas, determine the resources required, put together a tailored application, and in successful applications facilitate project implementation. They inform about new developments and publications on calls for funding, and carry out seminars on funding instruments and programmes with in-house or external speakers.

In this lunch talk Dr. Drossou-Berendes will give an overview of the common programmes for individual funding and point out some general requirements on the personal career profile of an applicant. She will shortly introduce the upcoming Horizon Europe Framework Programme, and show, how you are supported at GEOMAR.



Dr. Alexandra Drossou-Berendes is a fishery biologist who worked in Germany, Norway and China. In 2007 she switched from research to science management. She coordinated the scientific-technical cooperation with China "Sino German Initiative on Marine Sciences, funded by the BMBF, and co-applied for and managed the EU FP7 "Marie Curie Initial Training Network CALMARO - Calcification by Marine Organisms ", with 16 European and international partners. In 2011 she took over the research funding area at GEOMAR, for which she is still responsible today with a special focus on the EU funding landscape. She represents an interface function between science and administration.
